**CALL TO ORDER**

With a quorum present, the Chair, Ms. Williams, called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment.

**FORMAL INTRODUCTION OF NEW STAFF**

Ms. Whitley introduced Brad Jones, the new manager of the Authority to the Board. The Board welcomed Mr. Jones to the Authority.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The Chair asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the January 8, 2013 meeting of the Board of Directors of the Virginia Public Building Authority. Mr. Flinchum made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fulton and was unanimously approved by the Board Members. (Attachment A)

## **CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION HONORING TRACY L. CLEMONS, SR.**

Ms. Williams asked the Vice Chair, Mr. Flinchum, to read the Resolution (Attachment B) honoring the life of Tracy L. Clemons, Sr. Members of the Board shared memories of Mr. Clemons and his contributions to the Authority. The Board also complimented staff on the preparation of the Resolution. Ms. Whitley said the Resolution will be sent to Mr. Clemons' family.

Mr. Flinchum made a motion to approve the Resolution. The motion was seconded by Mr. Von Moll and passed with unanimous approval of the Board. (Attachment C)

## **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

Ms. Whitley provided an overview of the reason for the elections and explained that the by-laws require the elections every two years. The first positions up for nomination and approval were Secretary/Treasurer and Assistant Secretary/Treasurers #1 and #2. Ms. Whitley further explained that typically the Treasurer serves as Secretary/Treasurer, the Director of Debt Management serves as Assistant Secretary/Treasurer #1 and the VPBA Public Finance Manager serves as Assistant Secretary/Treasurer #2. However, the Board was informed they could choose other options. Ms. Williams asked the Board Members for nominations and Mr. Flinchum nominated the Treasurer to serve as Secretary/Treasurer, the Director of Debt Management to serve as Secretary/Treasurer #1 and the VPBA Public Finance Manager to serve as Secretary/Treasurer #2.

There was consensus among the Board to move forward with the slate of officers.

The Chair asked if there was a motion, and Mr. Flinchum made a motion to elect the slate of officers brought before the Board. Mr. Fulton seconded the motion and it passed with unanimous approval of the Board. (Attachment D).

The final position up for nomination and approval was Vice-Chair. The Chair asked the Board for nominations for the position of Vice-Chair of the Authority. Ms. Ganeriwala nominated Mr. James Flinchum to serve as Vice-Chair. Hearing no other nominations, Ms. Williams asked for a motion from the Board to elect Mr. Flinchum as Vice-Chair. Ms. Ganeriwala made the motion and the motion was seconded by Mr. Fulton. Mr. Flinchum was elected Vice-Chair after the unanimous approval of the Board. (Attachment E).

## **POST SALE ANALYSIS OF VPBA PUBLIC FACILITIES REVENUE AND REFUNDING BONDS SERIES 2013A&B**

Ms. Williams asked Ms. Cawthorn to review the Final Financing Summary (Exhibit 1) for the Series 2013A&B Bonds. At the January 8, 2013 meeting, the Board gave consideration to and approved the issuance of new money and refunding bonds. Ms. Cawthorn reported that the Authority received seven bids on February 7, 2013 and that Citigroup was the winning firm with a combined true interest cost of 2.43%. The Series 2013A TIC was 2.70% and the 2013B TIC was 1.74%. She also reported the level of net present value savings achieved from the refunding

portion totaled \$6,578,081.75 or 8.3909%. Ms. Williams commended the Board and staff on achieving the significant dollar amount of savings.

### **FINANCIAL ADVISOR SELECTION**

Ms. Whitley provided an overview of the procurement process and the motion approved by the Board at its last meeting, which directed staff's actions. Mr. Jones reviewed the development of the request for proposal ("RFP") and explained the review process. He stated that RFPs were distributed to seventeen financial advisors and five proposals were received. The five proposals were evaluated by staff and three finalists were selected to make presentations before the Board during the executive session of this meeting. The three finalists were said to be Public Resources Advisory Group, Acacia Financial Group, Inc. and Public Financial Management, Inc. Mr. Flinchum asked why the other two firms submitting proposals were not included in the interview process. Ms. Whitley responded that the three firms being interviewed were deemed most qualified. Mr. Von Moll asked if the firms had been ranked by cost and Ms. Whitley confirmed. Mr. Mahone asked about the questions the firms were to answer in the presentations. Mr. Jones provided a handout of the specific questions for each firm.

Ms. Whitley gave an explanation of the composition of the firms.

With the Board ready to begin the interview process, the Chair asked for a motion to convene a closed meeting under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act in order to discuss the procurement of financial advisors under Virginia Code §2.2-3711 (A) (30). Mr. Fulton made a motion to convene a closed meeting and cited the Code of Virginia as providing the authorization for this action. Mr. Flinchum seconded the motion and it passed with unanimous approval of the Board. (Attachment F) The Board convened its closed meeting at 1:35 p.m.

At 4:40 p.m. a motion was made by Mr. Flinchum to reconvene in open session. Ms. Ganeriwala seconded the motion and it passed with unanimous approval from the Board. (Attachment G)

Ms. Williams asked for another motion to certify the Committee conducted the closed meeting in conformity with Virginia law. Ms. Ganeriwala made a motion to approve the Resolution (Attachment H) and read the resolution as required by Virginia law. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fulton. As is required by Virginia law, a roll call vote was taken and the motion was certified by the following Board Members:

Ms. Williams asked for a motion to direct staff to begin negotiations with select Financial Advisory firms. A motion was made by Mr. Flinchum to direct staff to begin negotiations with Public Financial Management, LLC and Acacia Financial Group, Inc. to serve as Financial Advisors to the Authority and to delegate to the Secretary/Treasurer of the Authority the final contract terms. The motion was seconded simultaneously by Mr. Mahone and Mr. Von Moll and was passed unanimously by the Board. (Attachment I).

### **ADJOURNMENT**

Ms. Whitley informed the Board that it is anticipated the Authority will have a winter bond sale. Therefore, the Board may need to meet after the first of the year to approve the terms and structure of the next bond sale. Having no other business to be brought before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by the Chair asking if there was a motion to adjourn. While no formal motion was made or seconded, all Board Members were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 5:05 p.m. (Attachment J)
